



2018 PRIMARY SUMMER SCHOOL **July 9th – August 24th**

Welcome to One World Montessori's Summer School. The summer program is different from what we offer during the school year. We start the work period at 9:30 am instead of 9:00 am, which gives the children more time to play outside when it's not so hot. Outdoor time will be limited on "Spare the Air" days or when the temperature is over 100 degrees. The mornings are devoted to our usual Montessori schedule (excluding most Wednesdays which are reserved for special visitors) and the afternoons will be filled with a variety of preplanned activities. Please see the schedule that follows and the attached calendar.

Although it is summer school and things are a bit more relaxed, it is still important for children to have a regular routine. That means we need you to bring your children to school on time at 8:30 am. If you arrive after the morning work period has begun, but before 10 am, please wait with your child in the lobby. A teacher will step out of the classroom to collect late children at 9:45 am and at 10 am. If you arrive after 10 am, please call the school when you arrive in the lobby and a teacher will meet your child to escort him/her to the classroom.

SUNSCREEN

Please remember to apply sunscreen on your child in the morning before school. We will reapply sunscreen after lunch before the children go outside and again (if applicable) during daycare. Note that we must have your signed sunscreen release form to apply sunscreen to your child.

DROP OFF

We will have new students starting school here for the first time this summer. It sometimes upsets them when they see other parents in the playground, so we ask that you make your goodbyes brief and not hang around the playground or lobby area after you drop off your child.

NUT FREE ENVIRONMENT

We have a student that has a severe food allergy to peanuts and tree nuts. Due to the age of this child and the severity of the allergy, our summer program will be nut-free.

For summer school, please do not send any peanut or tree nut containing products in your child's lunchbox. For your reference, we listed the nuts that are not allowed below.

Alternatives to peanut butter that are acceptable include sun butter and Soy nut butter.
