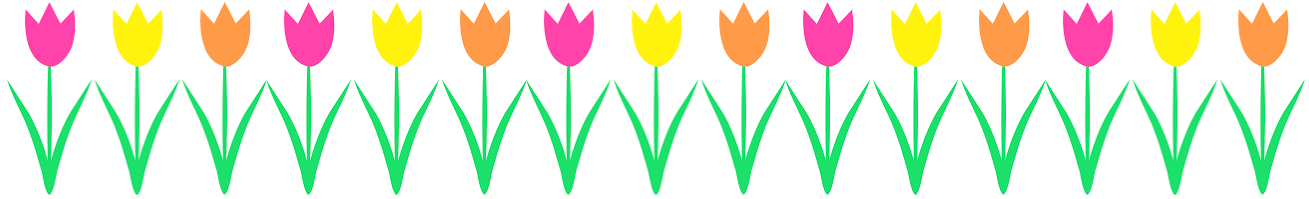




APRIL 2023 ELEMENTARY NEWSLETTER
